Tuesday Connections is held every Tuesday from 6:00pm to 9:00pm at [The Ugly Mug](#), located on Capitol Hill (723 8th Street, Southeast), across the street from the famous US Marine Corp Barracks. Tuesday Connections also features a DJ playing Old School R&B/Hip Hop and House Music, vendors, upcoming promotions, and an opportunity for the LGBTQ community to connect.
